What is Limestone?

Limestone is a sedimentary rock formed most commonly from calcite seashells. Which explains why Texas is rich with this stone! Millions of years ago, the Lone Star State lay beneath a sprawling prehistoric sea. Consequently, Texas limestone is plentiful and comes in many varieties: Cordoba Crème, Cedar Hill Crème, Leuders Gray, Hill Country White, and Sisterdale White to name but a few.

What can Stonehenge Custom Carving do for me?

scriptions and turn them into masterpieces! How do I get started?

Begin by determining where your carved stone masterpiece will stand. Then decide what it will stand *for*. Will it be a company logo affixed to an outside wall? Or will it be a subdivision entry stone with characteristic designs encircling the subdivision's name and mounted on a platform? Perhaps it's a pedestal to support an ancient artifact. Or maybe you want to memorialize a loved one. Whatever your purpose, the next step is to decide how large you want your stone work to be. Then take these
